We Will Speak Again (Speech)

Who are we?

We are the millions of poor people in this country who have no voice in our government.

We are the many who have worked all their lives, for one company, helped to make that country profitable, and many of its executives very wealthy, as well as stock holders, to collect a pension for their retirement, and who now learn there is none... or the rules have changed.

We are the women in this country who don't "support" abortion, or "promote" abortion, or the killing of babies, but feel it is a constitutional right to have a say about their own bodies.

We are the children who can't get school books and can't play after school because there is not enough money for after school programs...

We are the millions of employees of Walmart who are not allowed to organize, or even discuss their work conditions in a FREE Country!!

We are the millions of people who are willing to look at how we live as part of the problem and as an alternative to just pushing our way of life on others.
